The content language will be English (UK) with English (UK) spellings.

Example: labour, and NOT labor, neighbour and NOT neighbor, colour and NOT color; Please use 's' in place of 'z'; example: recognise, and NOT recognize, analyse,

and NOT analyze

Tables and figures in separate JEPG (high resolution, ideally 720+ /MS Word/Xlsx documents as attachments

Font: Garamond

Title: 16 (all caps, bold)

Sub-headings

Level-1 (principal or primary): 14 bold A/c

Level-2 (secondary): 13 bold u/l Level-3 (tertiary): 12 bold italic u/l

Normal Text: 12, words other than English in italics

Format: Left aligned, and NOT justified, with ample left margin and without hyphenation.

Acronyms and Abbreviations should be explained when appears first. EU, USA, UK, USSR having no full stop are easily understood.

Numbers higher than ten should be in figures (e.g. five, eight, ten, but 11, 99, 100); the % sign is used in place of 'percent' (0.3%, 3%, 30%).

Gender-neutrality: Frontpage encourages gender-neutral language as far as possible, and discards colloquialisms, especially if linked to a particular national culture.

Quotations: As for quotations, onus is on the author(s) for the accuracy as well as for obtaining the permission to quote, especially the longer quotes exceeding 40 words. Frontpage uses 'single' quotation marks; "double" quotation marks would be applicable only for 'quotations "within" quotations' and the longer quotes (exceeding 40 words) should be indented without any quotation mark in 11 pt size.

Footnotes/Endnotes: In printed text, only endnotes will appear; author(s) would insert superscripted figures as endnotes by using the function in MS Word.

In subsequent notes, 'ibid.' and 'op.cit.' need to be avoided.

Page numbers will appear as p.33 or pp.33-39.

In citing reference of any website, the URL with retrieval date(s) will be mentioned.

Biographical statement: In printed text, the bio-sketch of the contributors may be published; the biographical statement, to be submitted by the author(s), need to be brief (not exceeding 50 words) which should include present position and institutional affiliation, particulars of the highest academic degree obtained, present research interest, current position in a professional society/organisation, if any, and the particulars of the recent (co-)authored or edited publications.

Figures, Tables, and Exhibits having Arabic numerals with short, descriptive captions should be sent on separate pages in JPG (high resolution, ideally 720+)/MS Word/Xlsx documents as attachments.
